

Cougar Biotechnology, Inc. Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What does Cougar Biotechnology do?

A. Cougar is a development stage biopharmaceutical company based in Los Angeles, California that in-licenses novel therapeutics and develops such therapies for the treatment of cancer. Our strategy is to license technologies that have previously been tested in clinical trials, enabling us to obtain an initial indication of the drug's safety and biological activity in humans before committing capital to the drug's development.

Q. When was Cougar founded and where was it incorporated?

A. Cougar was founded as a private company in May 2003 and incorporated in Delaware.

Q. When did Cougar become a publicly reporting company?

A. On April 3, 2006, Cougar completed a reverse merger with a publicly reporting company SRKP 4, Inc., a Delaware corporation. The transaction was completed by the merger of a wholly-owned subsidiary of SRKP 4 with Cougar, with Cougar remaining as the surviving company and a wholly owned operating subsidiary of SRKP 4. SRKP 4 was renamed Cougar Biotechnology, Inc. following completion of the merger.

Q. On which exchange is Cougar's stock traded and what is its stock symbol?

A. Cougar began trading on the OTC Bulletin Board[®] (OTCBB) under the ticker symbol "CRGB.OB" on February 8, 2007.

Q. How many shares are outstanding?

A. As of May 15, 2007, approximately 17.5 million shares of common stock were issued and outstanding. In addition, approximately 3.3 million shares are reserved for issuance according to the terms of the Company's 2003 Stock Option Plan, as amended.

Q. What is Cougar's CUSIP number?

A. The CUSIP number for Cougar common stock is 222083107
